They were not on their own, however. They were given the Holy Spirit. They had the Hebrew scriptures. They had memories of Jesus' own teaching and miracles. And, they had one another. We have these same things available to us (as well as the rest of the New Testament) to guide us in answering the question "So, now what?" I hope you will join us for worship in-person or tune in online to hear these messages and ponder the wisdom of the book of Acts. There will also be an opportunity to meet together for more in-depth Bible study and discussion (see details inside). One thing I firmly believe – we may not know all the answers, but God is faithful and will guide us! So, friends, let us boldly seek and follow the Holy Spirit as we ponder the question, "So, now what?"?


